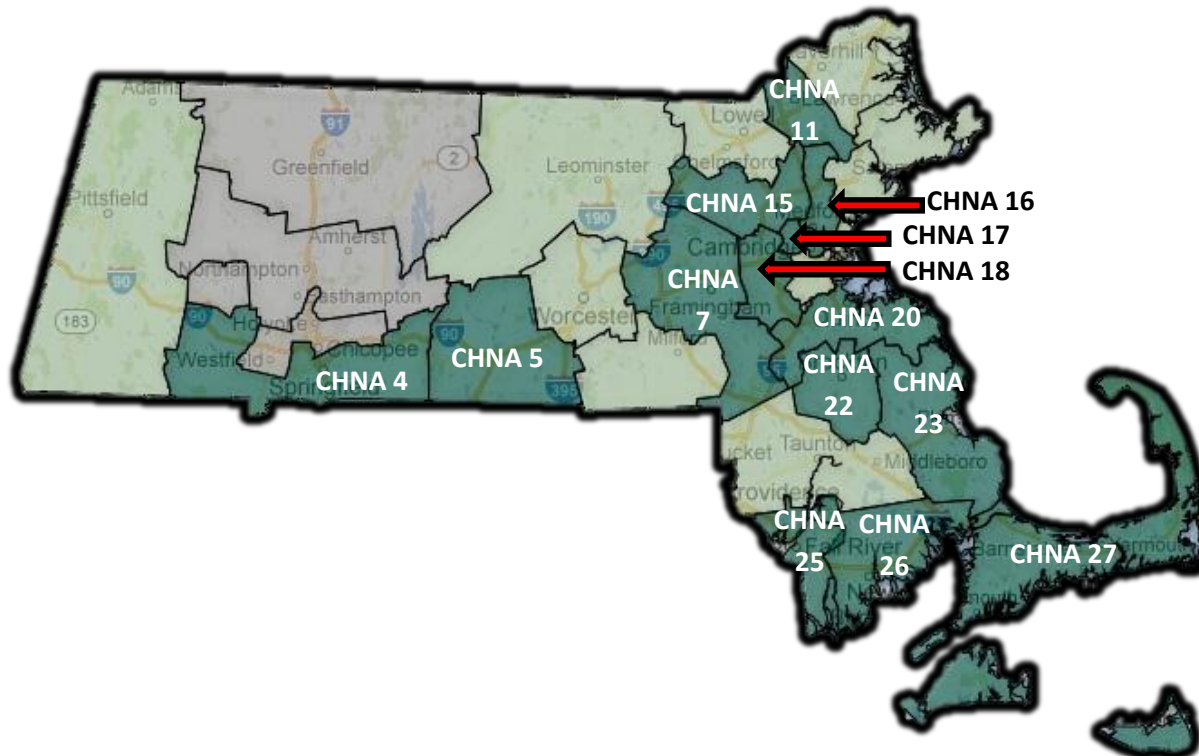


Massachusetts Community Health Network Areas: Access to Care
